Our tour started in the pine woods and Big Thicket north and east of Houston where we found specialties including Red-cockaded Woodpecker and Bachman's Sparrow as well as many residents and migrants that nest in the area. We spent the rest of the tour on or near the Gulf Coast where we saw migrants arriving from Central America and many resident birds.

In addition to 197 species of birds, we recorded 5 species of mammals, and 6 species of reptiles.
