

# Northern Tanzania Safari Species List | February 8 – 22, 2024 with Naturalist Journeys

**Summary:** There is no way to succinctly describe the wonders of birds and mammals seen on a safari on the northern Serengeti circuit, where National Geographic moments appear almost daily. We had a most compatible group, excellent drivers and guides and we filled our days with field time. We saw the large iconic birds including Common Ostrich, Secretarybird, Southern Ground Hornbill, Gray-crowned Crane, Kori Bustard, various herons, two species of flamingo, amazing raptors, 27 species! And many elusive species such as in Quail and Three-banded Courser. We learned so many tips to identifying the more difficult "little brown jobs" and logged four species of coursers and three species of sandgrouse. We saw four members of the intriguing turaco family and ten types of cuckoos. Memorable was watching a Kori Bustard display against the background of incredible beauty of Ngorongoro Crater, discovering Gray-crowned Crane pairs with chicks, finding a Bronze-winged Courser and watching a Pearl-spotted Owlet devour a frog on our Tarangire night drive. For many species we watched courtship and some had fledgling young, though common we had fun watching and trying to photograph (yet again!) colorful bee-eaters and rollers take flight. Mammal watching was primo as well, a very successful safari!
