

Nevada's Great Basin Species List | August 23-30, 2024 with Naturalist Journeys

Fall migration trip to Utah and Nevada. We started in Salt Lake City and birded several wetland areas including Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge and Antelope Island State Park. Shorebird numbers were impressive and we saw thousands of Avocets, Wilson's and Red-neck Phalarope, and others. From there we drove west across the Salt Flats to Elko, NV where we explored the Ruby Mountains and surrounding areas. Last but not least we spent 3 nights at Great Basin National Park. While there we hiked and birded our way into a Bristlecone Pine Grove and toured Lehman Caves before we returned to Salt Lake.

We recorded 154 species of birds during our tour. The bird list and locations can be seen here:
