## Christmas in Ecuador | December 20-29, 2024 | eBird Trip Report

**Andean Duck** Oxyura ferruginea — (x) First seen in San Pablo lake after lunch n Cabañas el Lago, Imbabura Province, later in La Mica Lake in Antisana.

## **GUANS AND CURASSOWS: Cracidae — (2)**

**Andean Guan** *Penelope montagnii* — **(x)** A couple by the side of the road going to Baños area in Cayambe-Coca National Park, uphill the Hotspring Resort.

**Crested Guan** *Penelope purpurascens -* (x) A group feeding in Paz de las Aves Reserve feeding on berries in front of the restaurant.

**Rock Pigeon (I)** Columba livia — (x) along the driving in populated areas.

White-booted Racket-tail Ocreatus underwoodii— (x) Sachatamia feeders.

Fawn-breasted Brilliant Heliodoxa rubinoides — (x) Feeders in Guaycapi Lodge.

**Andean Gull** Chroicocephalus serranus — (x) Near La Mica Lake in Antisana Ecological Reserve.

**Neotropic Cormorant** *Nannopterum brasilianum* — (x) A couple standing by the lake in San Pablo.

## **HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae — (1)**

**Cattle Egret** Bubulcus ibis — (x) A group with cattle in our driving to Cuicocha Lake.

## IBISES AND SPOONBILLS: Threskiornithidae — (1)

**Andean Ibis** Theristicus branickii — (x) A very close view in Antisana Ecological Reserve fields.

## NEW WORLD VULTURES: Cathartidae — (2)

Andean Condor Vultur gryphus — (x) An excellent view of an adult crossing in front of the group, two more after that.

**Black Vulture** *Coragyps atratus* — **(x)** Along the driving in main roads.

Swallow tailed Kite Elanoides forficatus — (x) Mashpi Lodge

**Variable Hawk** *Geranoaetus polyosoma* — (x) Soaring in Papallacta Pass.

**Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle** *Geranoaetus melanoleucus* — **(x)** On our way back to Tambocondor in Antisana Ecological Reserve.

Red billed Parrot Pionus sordidus— (x) Perched on a palm tree in Refugio Paz de las Aves.

#### OVENBIRDS AND WOODCREEPERS: Furnariidae — (14)

**Strong-billed Woodcreeper** *Xiphocolaptes promeropirhynchus* — (x) Seen in San Tadeo Birding working in a bromeliad and later in Refugio Paz de las Aves.

**Plain-brown Woodcreeper** — (x) One of the visitors of the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Spotted Woodcreeper** — (x) One of the visitors of the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Montane Woodcreeper** *Lepidocolaptes lacrymiger* — (x) in Refugio Paz de las Aves.

**Chestnut-winged Cinclodes** *Cinclodes albidiventris* — (x) By the road in Antisana, came in front of the group.

**Scaly-throated Foliage Gleaner** — (x) Mashpi Lodge.

**Lineated Foliage Gleaner** — (x) One of the visitors of the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Buff-fronted Foliage Gleaner** — (x) Mashpi Lodge

**Streaked-capped Treehunter** — (x) One of the visitors of the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Spotted Barbtail— (x)** One of the visitors of the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Stout-billed Cinclodes** *Cinclodes excelsior* — **(x)** At the same time that Chestnut-winged Cinclodes in Antisana Ecological Reserve.

Andean Tit-Spinetail Leptasthenura andicola — (x) On the top of a bush in Papallacta Pass.

White-chinned Thistletail Asthenes fuliginosa — (x) On the top of a bush in Papallacta Pass.

Azara's Spinetail Synallaxis azarae — (x) Heard only in Guaycapi lodge.

**Orange- breasted Fruiteater** *Pipreola jucunda*— (x) A pair seen very close in Refugio Paz de las Aves.

**Andean Cock-of-the-rock** *Rupicola peruvianus*— (x) Around 5 individuals in the lek in Refugio Paz de las Aves.

**Long-wattled Umbrellabird** *Cephalopterus penduliger*— **(x)** In Sachatamia Lodge, first by the parking place and later in the moth trap.

Black-tipped Cotinga Carpodectes hopkei— (x) Mashpi Lodge.

**Red-rumped Bush-Tyrant** *Cnemarchus erythropygius* — (x) Perched on a wire in Papallacta Pass.

**Black-billed Shrike-Tyrant** *Agriornis montanus* — (x) By the road near an abandoned house in Antisana Ecological Reserve.

**Brown-backed Chat-Tyrant** *Ochthoeca fumicolor* — (x) From the car in Papallacta Pass.

Rusty-margined Flycatcher Myiozetetes cayanensis— (x) Mashpi Lodge.

Golden-bellied Flycatcher Myiodynastes hemichrysus— (x) Visiting the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

**Tropical Kingbird** *Tyrannus melancholicus* — (x) While driving, perched on wires.

**Turquoise Jay** Cyanolyca turcosa — (x) Great views in the parking lot of Guango Lodge.

Blue-and-white Swallow Pygochelidon cyanoleuca — (x) Mashpi Lodge and near Sachatamia Lodge.

**Brown-bellied Swallow** *Oreochelidon murina* — (x) Spotted in open fields in Antisana ecological Reserve.

**Barn Swallow** *Hirundo rustica* — (x) Together with Brown-bellied Swallow in Antisana.

## WRENS: Troglodytidae — (5)

**Mountain Wren** *Troglodytes solstitialis* — (x) Visiting the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.

Grass Wren Cistothorus platensis — (x) Vocalizing from the grasses in Antisana ecological Reserve.

**Rufous Wren** Cinnycerthia unirufa — (x) Moving with a mix flock in Baños Area in Cayambe-Coca Reserve.

**Gray-breasted Wood-Wren** Henicorhina leucophrys — (x) Visiting the moth trap in Sachatamia Lodge.
