## Best of Belize Species List | February 8 – 17, 2025 with Naturalist Journeys

Two guests arrived early and joined Chris for a night at Black Orchid Lodge on the Belize River. The rest of the group met up at Bird's Eye View the following day where we spent two nights. We enjoyed two trips out accompanied by local guide Michael and the other walks with Chris. We then journeyed by road and boat to Lamanai Outpost Lodge where we spent three nights with trips out accompanied by local guide Eduardo, visiting Indian Church (local village), the Lamanai Archaeological Reserve, New River, and Dawson's Creek Savannah. A long drive then took us to Chan Chich Lodge where we spent three nights. Local guide Levy led us on walks into the forest, and excellent drives into the wider countryside.

BIRDS: 242 species were recorded of which five were heard only, seven were Yucatan endemics and 2 were introduced. Details are included below.
